

Kondo vs. Chaos February 7 - March 1, 2020 Opening Reception: Friday, February 7 from 7-9pm

Marie Kondo's technique has brought simplicity and order to millions of devotees. Her principles have struck a chord with those overwhelmed by "stuff." Some artists

thrive on, or at least live with, chaos. They eschew the orderly static world and value dynamism. Some painters, like the Dutch still life artists, depicted "organized chaos." They painted carefully chaotic scenes of overcrowded tables that overflowed with platters of flowers, fowls and fruits. Picasso used chaos in his electrifying Guernica painting to show the horrors, terrors and the randomness of war. Simplicity and chaos co-exist in the minds of many and in the world at large. This exhibit enables artists to externalize these concepts. The *Kondo vs. Chaos* exhibit is
