Playing with Resin Workshop

Monday, June 15 from 6-9pm (Register by June 12) - Instructor Tracy Wilkerson will teach you the ins and outs of mixing resin and using it in your artwork as an adhesive, a covering, or the main medium. You'll leave your finished masterpieces to set at the gallery at the end of the workshop, and pick them up later in the week. Instruction fee: \$40 member / \$50 non-member; plus \$10 supply fee.

Summer Sketchcrawl

Sunday, June 28, 1-3pm (Register by June 25) - Learn how to pick the right art supplies; sketch while sight-seeing; do loose, on-the-spot sketches; draw street scenes; break down complex subjects to create detailed, in-depth drawings; and more. Instructor Joan Bickelhaupt will suggest different compositional approaches to sketching in ink, pencil, or watercolor. Participants will then spend their time putting those suggestions into practice. Instruction fee: \$15 member / \$20 non-member; plus \$20 supply fee or bring your own supplies.

ONLINE: How to Publish Your Work in Literary Journals Workshop

Anna Sherlock-Office Manager


I started as the office manager of Del Ray Artisans in 2017. During the pandemic, I work from home, and go into the office
