Recent Sales Stats

Overall comparing 2020 to 2019 sales (Jan 1-Sept 15 each year), Del Ray Artisans has made 34% less; however, considering the gallery was closed this year from March 23-June 17 and Art Camp 2020 was cancelled, we should be proud of the performance to-date. Not everything is rosy, but sharing and selling art during a very difficult year is still a success story. The Board and staff have been diligent in keeping expenses low and applying for additional grants, so the organization remains on-track to balance this year's budget.

Regarding recent exhibit performance, in the first online-only *Art by Mail* exhibit from May 15-Aug 4, 114 pieces sold and brought in \$3,274.75 in artists' sales. In the *Hello, Bright Eyes* exhibit (August 2020), 27 pieces sold and brought in \$1,872 in artists' sales; 4 of those pieces (\$180) were from online sales; 8 pieces (\$602) were sold during the City-wide Alexandria Sidewalk Sale, plus an additional \$59 in DRA merchandise sales. Thank you to the artists for donating a percentage of sales to Del Ray Artisans.

Thank you to the many member volunteers and patrons that have been making a difference in supporting DRA's mission and keeping the arts visible while we social distance. Stay safe and creative!
