The HOPE Quilt

On November 21 Del Ray Artisans and the *Women's Right To Vote* exhibit hosted Covid-19 US Honor Quilt Founder, Diane Canney for a painting and tribute event.

Until January 19, 2021 the Hope Quilt Project will donate \$5 to Del Ray Artisans for each artist submitting a handcrafted panel created to honor a front-line worker or a person in memoriam. Drop off panel artwork at the gallery to be delivered to the Hope Quilt for assembly.

The Team of Marlin G. Lord and Kathryn A. Brown

Marlin and Kathryn, among the Founding Members of Del Ray Artisans, are both transplanted but proud, long-time residents of Del Ray. Both have spent all of their years here actively involved in elevating Del Ray, the arts community, and greater Alexandria, being honored in 2013 as Living Legends of Alexandria, as "The Team of Marlin G. Lord and Kathryn A. Brown."

Marlin has been an architect for his entire career, and finally allowed himself to retire just at the beginning of 2020. Kathryn began working in architectural engineering drafting, and moved into her own business as a photographer, and now bookkeeper. Both have created and exhibited a wealth of photographic art, with Marlin also painting and drawing, and Kathryn dabbling in stained glass and mosaics.

Marlin was instrumental in securing the Colasanto Center as DRA's current home, and has served as DRA Treasurer, Facilities Director, and Community/Business Liaison Director, and was voted by the Board in 2020 to become the first Member Emeritus, to honor his service to DRA above-and-beyond. Kathryn was chair of the original Selections Committee, curator of numerous exhibits, including one held in the Target Gallery of the Torpedo Factory, and served as Assistant Treasurer, Membership Director, and currently serves on the Personnel Committee and as Secretary.
