Life in the time of COVID-19 this past year has created an inorganic state of a nearly lost humanity. The pervasive experiences of solitude, isolation, loneliness, longing, and reverie are a common thread in the paintings of Edward Hopper. Hopper's iconic emblem of Post-Depressionera America and a world at war, "Nighthawks," recalls not only the dire times of economic uncertainty but a world lost. Artists are invited to enter their own existential explorations and expressions in response to COVID-19.

A visit to the understated world of *Edward Hopper in Paris* (currently at DC's Phillips Collection) is just the ticket to foster creative inspiration for entering artwork in the Hopper-themed February show at DRA. Hopper spent a year in Paris observing everyday life in the City of Light. These works reflect the advent of his transformative vision of the 20th century American zeitgeist - both urban and urbane.

The Phillips Collection has remained open during this time when the escalating COVID-19 crisis has resulted in temporary closures of most of the museums and galleries in the area.
