After Edward Hopper: Themes of Solitude and Isolation Runs February 5-27, 2021

Life in the time of COVID-19 this past year has created an inorganic state of a nearly lost humanity. The pervasive experiences of solitude, isolation, loneliness, longing, and reverie are a common thread in the paintings of Edward Hopper. Hopper's iconic emblem of Post-Depressionera America and a world at war, "Nighthawks," recalls not only the dire times of economic uncertainty but a world lost. Artists are invited to enter their own existential explorations and expressions in response to COVID-19.

Reserve a ticket now for a half-hour viewing during the extended hours on opening day: Friday, February 5 between 12-8pm. For tickets: after-hopper.eventbrite.com. Opening day tickets are not required, but ticket holders have priority entry. The gallery capacity is limited to 10 people at any one time in order to facilitate social distancing. Unfinished/Finished runs April 2 – May 1, 2021 Sign Up for Random Pairing by February 3 Call for Entry Deadline: Sunday, March 14

As artists, most of us have unfinished pieces hidden in our workspaces. This exhibit challenges us to share those pieces with other artists and see how the "start" inspires a "finish" by someone else. Artists may selfpair with someone they know -OR- sign up (by February 3) to be randomly paired.

Unfinished/Finished is open to all area artists and area high school students. High school students are invited to participate for free (no entry fee). The digital entry deadline is Sunday, March 14 for both the (in theme) exhibit and (no theme) marketplace. Entry details at DelRayArtisans.org/cfe.

Call for Entry Form Change

To better assist DRA volunteers who are posting exhibits online, a tweak has been made to the entry requirements. Formerly artists were asked to name their image files: YourLast-Name-FirstName-Entry1, YourLastName-FirstName-Entry2, etc. The new process is for artists to name their image files: YourLastName-FirstName-ArtworkTitle. All other image file requirements remain the same (accepted file types: jpg, jpeg, pdf, png, and gif; up to 5MB in file size). The photos you submit with your entry form may be used online to advertise your artwork and the exhibit as a whole.

Reminder that these changes took effect last summer due to the pandemic:

- Volunteer hours are not required. Gallery hosting is only done by ALX Promise certified staff and members.
- Work previously shown at Del Ray Artisans gallery may be (or may not be) eligible to be entered. The curators are given the authority to decide this requirement for their exhibit. Read each Call for Entry carefully.
- Every exhibit will have an associated "Art-to-Go" marketplace opportunity. The curators decide if the marketplace follows (or does not follow) the theme of the exhibit, as well as the maximum number of entries.
- Artists must *enter* the main exhibit in order to also enter the marketplace. Marketplace acceptance is no longer contingent on exhibit *acceptance* (only on exhibit *submission*).
- Exhibit and marketplace entries are due online on the same date, but there are different entry forms. The marketplace entry form is linked off of the exhibit entry form.
- Artwork drop off and pick up is done by appointment only. Curators will email the artists with accepted work the sign up sheets for appointments.
- Face masks are required and please maintain 6' of personal space when inside the gallery.
- There are no receptions. No more than 10 people are allowed in the gallery at any one time.
- Half-hour viewing appointments are available during the extended hours (12-8pm) on the Opening Day of each exhibit.
