Together is a special invitation-only exhibit, curated by Amy Kitchin (Volunteers Director) and Joshua Oliveira, that honors current Del Ray Artisans (DRA) members who have worked tirelessly and made exceptional volunteer hour contributions to this community-based nonprofit over the past two years. Together presents a special opportunity for these members to showcase their artwork.

The last time Del Ray Artisans presented a similar exhibit, called Thanks For All The Fish (curated by Kathy Turner and Joshua Oliveira), was in June 2017. We are delighted to bring back this show this year!

Playing with Resin Workshop Tuesday, August 24, 6-9pm

Learn the ins and outs of mixing resin and using it in your artwork as an adhesive, a covering, or the main medium. There's lots of creative time during this 3-hour workshop...no need to rush, which is one of the first lessons in using resin! You'll leave your finished masterpiece(s) to set at the gallery at the end of the workshop, and pick them up during gallery hours later in the week. All supplies are included in the supplies fee, and you may bring your own items to further customize your work. Register by August 21 at DelRayArtisans. org/event/resin-august-2021. Face masks required for unaccinated individuals and recommended for everyone. The instruction fee is \$40 for DRA members and \$50 for non-members; plus a \$10 supply fee.








