

# Free Zoom Talk: The Many Faces of Hammer Tuesday, November 23, 7-8pm

In this talk Tom Birkhead will consider a variety of work from the classic era of the British studio Hammer Film Productions. He aims to shed some light on Hammer films to those who may have forgotten them or never sought them out, illuminating their interest and vitality as something that can still stand alongside more acclaimed works. As a foundation he will talk about their traditional "Gothic" films such as "The Curse of Frankenstein" and "Dracula: Prince of Darkness," and others that share in old fashioned evils, highlighting aspects of performance or plot or direction that offer more refined quality. Then he will move on to films of more contemporary concerns. He hopes to inspire some fresh appreciation and thought about Hammer, and encourage people to return to their films which he holds quite dear.
