## Flora & Fauna Exhibit Runs March 4-26, 2022

Join us on opening day, Friday, March 4 between 12-9pm for the *Flora & Fauna* art exhibit at Del Ray Artisans gallery. In recent years, climate change and pollution have endangered the complex interactions between plants and animals. Pollinators (birds, bats, bees, butterflies, beetles, and other small mammals) are vital to creating and maintaining the habitats and ecosystems that many rely on for food and shelter. Plants like almond trees, berry bushes and flowers

need pollinators to survive and reproduce. Large animals, like giraffes and elephants, rely on plants for food, shelter, and shade to protect them from the environment and predators. This art exhibit is focused on exploring and showing these connections and interdependence.

Held in conjunction with this exhibit, attend the free online talk by Master Naturalist Chris Allgyer about dragonflies and damselflies of Virginia on Wednesday, March 9 from 7-8pm. Details and registration at
