

## Drips, Lines, Splatters, and Splash: A Celebration of the Washington Color School Exhibit Runs May 6-28

Both representational and abstract expressions of color, line, movement, and sense of space are explored in *Drips, Lines, Splatters, and Splash: A Celebration of the Washington Color School* at Del Ray Artisans.

The exhibit was inspired by and celebrates the work of Morris Louis, Gene Davis, Jacob Kainen, among other founders and followers of the Washington Color School, a group of abstract painters who formed the movement in the 1950s and 1960s in rebellion against the art establishment of the day. The exhibit is curated by Kelly MacConomy.

The special guest juror is Washington area painter Barbara Januszkiewicz, who studied with two well-known members of the Washington Color School, Paul Reed and Hilda Thorpe. Barbara's organic abstractions are transcendental, bold and oftentimes colossal, composed with a masterful brushstroke.

In addition to getting a sneak peek of the exhibit, join us on First Thursday, May 5 from 6-9pm to create a "Washington Color Rule-the-School" canvas in Colasanto Park outside the gallery and recreate a Gene Davis Stripe Sidewalk Painting. #### Making Mosaic Art Workshop Monday, May 9-Wednesday, May 11, 6-9pm (3 days)



Create an 8" x 8" mosaic art work for indoor display, using a variety of materials such as stained glass, vitreous tiles and other beautiful glass. Have fun while you learn to cut glass and build your piece, tessera by tessera. We will touch upon design, adhesives, appropriate substrates for indoor use, etc. Learn how to grout and finish your piece. Students are encouraged to create their own simple design, but some basic design options will be provided. Completed pieces are grouted on the

In this three-hour class we'll learn some basic skills and explore ways to tame watercolor and have some fun. Do you love books and want to learn how to make your own? In this workshop you will learn how to create a long stitch journal. The long stitch is only one of the many styles of exposed spine sewing and is one of the easiest for beginners. The course will take place over two days. Day one will be a general introduction and the creation and construction of the exterior of the book. Day two will be preparing the spine and paper and sewing the signatures.

Open to all area artists. Artists need not imitate Washington Color School artists or even adhere to the precepts of Abstract Expressionism, but entries should exhibit remarkable use of color, movement, line, and sense of space. This applies to representational art as well as mixed media and three dimensional pieces, fiber work, and jewelry design.

# Afros and Abstract (June 3–25, 2022)
