Return to Eating, Drinking, and Merriment Art Exhibit Runs October 7-29, 2022 Opening Reception: Friday, October 7, 7–9pm

In Ecclesiastes it is written that "there is nothing good for a man under the sun except to eat and to drink and to be merry." The Return to Eating, Drinking, and Merriment exhibit celebrates the way that food and drink bring people together and bring joy to our lives. It is a hybrid show that combines a national ceramic cup show focused on drinking vessels; with a regional two-dimensional and non-ceramic three-dimensional show that echoes these themes.

The exhibit is juried by Jeremy Wallace, a nationally recognized wood and soda fired potter, who completed a year-long residency at the Morean Center for Clay in St. Petersburg, FL and then returned to Baltimore in 2014 as the Lormina Salter Fellow at Baltimore Clayworks where he currently maintains his studio practice.
