

Flag Book Workshop - Saturday, January 6, 10am-noon



Take a dive into the world of artists' books – works of art in book form – while creating a flag book. Flag books can look complicated, but you'll be surprised how doable they are once you learn the steps, and how delightful they are to look at and experience. Your completed flag book will be ready to enhance with any type of content: text or images. Bring these supplies of your own to the workshop:

Ruler (12" or longer), cutting board or piece of cardboard (12" x 12" or larger, scissors, pencil, metal spoon, colored markers or colored pencils (optional).


