professional development in the realm of diversity, equity, inclusion, accessibility and anti-bias and anti-racist education.





Block Printing 2.0 Workshop: Beyond the Basics Saturday, May 4, 9am-noon

This workshop is for those who have the basics of single ink block printing, but want to do more. We'll go beyond the basics by learning about enhancing designs with linear art techniques, exploring ways to add additional color and interest

through double-ink and simple reduction ink printing, and using post-printing enhancement techniques, such as collage and mixed media.

Zen Brush Calligraphy Sunday, May 5, 9:30am-noon

Join us for a cup of green tea, jasmine pearls, genmaicha, or other teas (tea provided) and learn about the four treasures of East Asian style calligraphy (brush, ink, ink stone, and paper). We will practice with the brush and explore personal expression using sumi ink on rice paper. The final project will be a

weathergram to hang outside and a small booklet of our practice. All art materials are included in the supply fee.

Paint Your Own Tessellated Tea Mug Sunday, May 19, 10am-1pm

Tessellation is a method of artistic decoration that has been used for centuries in the Islamic world to decorate ceramics, architecture, and textiles. Learn to paint a tessellated pattern on a mug. The supply fee includes one ceramic bisque mug, food safe underglazes, glaze, and firing services. Finished pieces

will be ready for pick-up at the gallery approximately two weeks following the workshop. All skill levels.

Del Ray Urban Sketchers Sunday, May 12, 1-3pm




Bring your supplies and join Joan Bickelhaupt outside to produce still life, figure, or architecture subjects in your sketchbook. This is a free, drop-in program
