

Color Explosion Workshop - Saturday, June 8, 9am-noon



Explore the properties and possibilities of using color in all types of art. Learn color optics and how our brain "sees" colors, the cultural and emotional aspects of color, demystifying mixing and matching colors, and creating fun and practical optical color illusions in collage.

Soft Pastel Workshop - Saturday, June 15, 6:30-8:30pm



Learn the basics of creating dreamy landscapes using soft pastels, an often overlooked medium. This is a great introduction to the basics of color blending, layering, texture, harmony, and balance. As a bonus, we will experiment with Pan Pastel, a new form of soft pastel, with no extra supply fee.

Playing with Resin - Monday, June 17, 6-9pm

Learn the ins and outs of prepping for and mixing resin, and how to use it as an adhesive, a covering, or the main medium. There's lots of creative time during this 3-hour workshop. No need to rush, which is one of the first lessons in using resin! All supplies are provided, but feel free to bring personal

embellishments for your piece(s).

Introduction to Stone Carving Workshop - Saturday, June 22, 9am-noon



Learn basic sculpting techniques by carving in soapstone—a beautiful, soft stone that is ideal for your first stone sculpture. You will sketch an idea in three dimensions to picture what it will look like; then sculpt, sand and finish the artwork. You'll use tools such as knives, rasps and saws; and then finish and polish your work. Soapstone finishes beautifully!

Life Drawing Gesture and Short Pose Tuesdays, June 18 and 25, 7-9pm




Bring your supplies and join us at the gallery to draw or paint our nude model. Traditional drawing media
