

The installation is 40 feet wide by 7 feet tall and was created using natural and synthetic yarn, fabric trim, mylar, plastic, and vinyl. River Towers Condominium Association donated knitted and crocheted pieces from a yarn bomb formerly at the condominium complex and DRA artists reformed them into "candles" to celebrate the City's anniversary. 
