Artwork Presentation Guidelines

Be sure that your artwork is properly prepared for display for every exhibit. Remember to have screw eyes and wire on the back of 2-D pieces for hanging (do not use "sawtooth" hangers), paintings on canvas must have finished edges or be framed, and make sure the frame is sturdy and looks nice.
