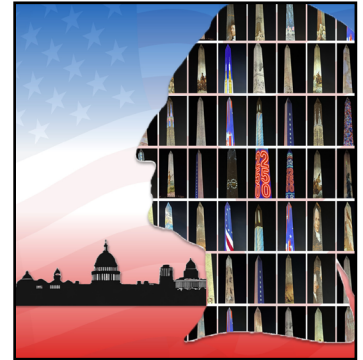
## USA at 250 Art Exhibition

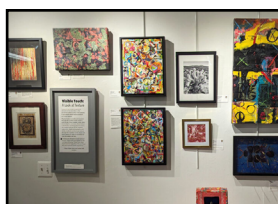

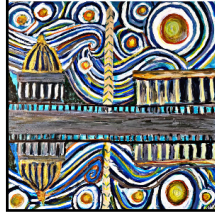
